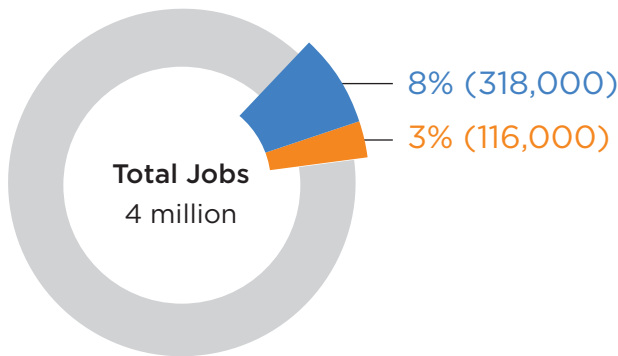




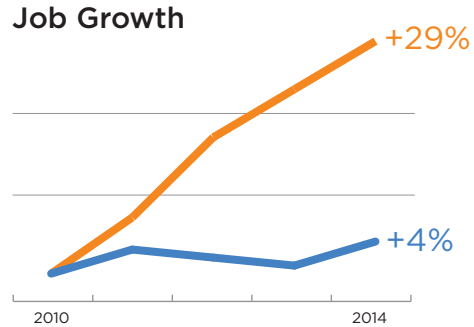

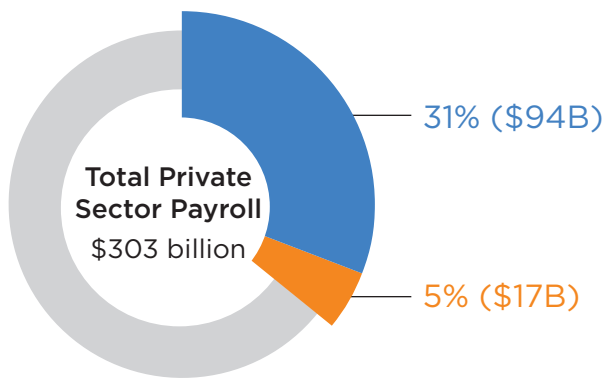
Financial Services High-tech



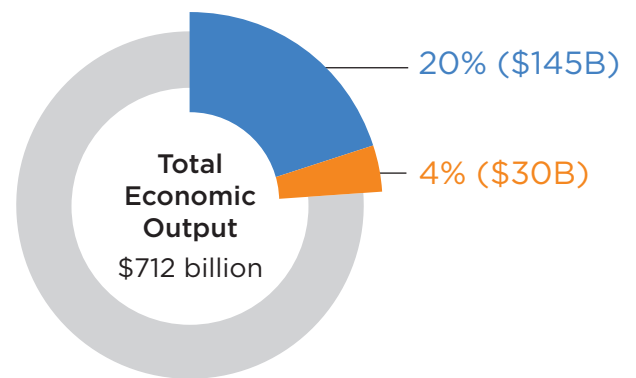
Financial Services employs 318,000 people; the high-tech sector employs 116,000.



Job growth in Financial Services has been modest over the past five years, while the high-tech sector has grown 29%, outpacing all other sectors.



Financial Services accounts for 31% of the city's private sector payroll; the high-tech sector accounts for 5%.



Financial Services generates 20% of the city's economic output; the high-tech sector generates 4%.

Convergence

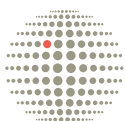
IPO \$5.7 billion

Silicon Alley has produced eight tech IPOs since 2012, worth \$5.7 billion in total.
