



Meals for H+H Medical Staff Feeding our Frontline Healthcare Workers

The Mayor's Fund to Advance New York City is a City-affiliated 501(c)(3) chaired by First Lady Chirlane McCray that partners with 50 City agencies and offices, 300 institutional funders, and 100 community-based organizations to advance critical initiatives to benefit New Yorkers across the five boroughs.

The Mayor's Fund is currently raising funds to support frontline staff at the 11 hospitals and other facilities in the New York City Health + Hospitals (NYC H+H) system. These medical professionals are working around the clock and in many cases are unable to return home to their families or take the time to eat a hot meal.

NYC H+H facilities like Elmhurst Hospital in Queens and Bellevue in Manhattan are working tirelessly to treat thousands of individuals suffering from COVID-19 each day, and we are doing all that we can to provide these workers with relief.

Your support will enable the Mayor's Fund to provide fresh pre-packaged meals to health care staff while maintaining proper social distancing to prevent further spread of COVID-19.

NYC H+H estimates that it will need 100,000 meals per week for frontline workers in the coming weeks. Your gift will help us provide the following:
